Please Note: Applications cannot be accepted for the sale of food or soft drinks to be consumed on site e.g. burgers, canned drinks etc. This is because our caterers hold sole concession rights.

Please Note also: There is no electricity on site other than in the Food Fayre tent. You may bring your own generator which must have a safety certificate. There are cold water taps around the show field.

In order that you are aware of what is required of you on show day, you must read and abide by the regulations and guidelines below. You must sign the application form to confirm that you have done so.

Exhibitors are required at all times to follow instructions issued to them by the Show's Trade Stand Stewards, office bearers and committee members.

1. The space you have booked is allocated to you and cannot be changed on show day. If the stand space you have booked cannot accommodate your vehicle, it must be removed as soon as you have unloaded your wares. There is no charge at any of the show's car parks. Vehicles on stands must stay there for the duration of the show.
2. You will receive complimentary entry passes, 2 for stands 3m x 6m and 6m x 6m, 3 for 9m x 6m and 4 for 12m x 12m. Additional people travelling with you will require to pay the required entry fee.
3. Entrance to the Showground is permitted from 7am on Saturday when Stewards will direct you to your allotted space. Access to the showground on Friday afternoon to set up, will only be permitted with the prior consent of the secretary who must be notified before the Wednesday prior to the show.
4. Exhibitors are responsible for the erection of their stands and are required to have their merchandise in place by 9.30 am on show day. Goods displayed must be in accordance with the description given on the Entry Form. Stands must be open and continuously manned from 10am onwards.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for the security of their entries. The organisers will not be held responsible for loss or damage to stands or exhibits however caused. The Marquee is in use on both Friday and Saturday evenings therefore Exhibitors should secure any stands, vehicles or caravans left on site.
- 6 The dismantling of Stands is permitted from approx.5pm.
7. The organisers will not be responsible for any accident caused by the exhibitors stand, or exhibits, or personnel, including machinery or equipment belonging to any exhibitor. It is a condition of entry that exhibitors shall hold the organisers blameless and indemnify the organisers against any legal proceedings or claims arising from any accident caused by the aforesaid.
8. The use of mechanical loud speaking appliances is prohibited.
- 9 In the event of the Show being terminated early due to inclement weather, or for any other reason, there shall be no refund of fee.
10. Any complaints must be made in writing to the secretary before 6p.m. on the day after the Show. The committee shall reserve the right to decline applications in future years from those making derogatory comments on social media about Echt Show or persons connected with the Show.
11. Trade Stand Competition: Each stand will be judged after 11am for the best display. The winner will receive a Trophy to be returned on Show day next year

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
