ROPE MAKING – from 11.00am

(This competition will supplement Echt Show's celebration of Scotland's Year of Heritage)

Clubs can enter a maximum of **one** team. Each team to consist of three members. Teams can have senior, junior or lady members.

Competition: Competitors must make a 3 ply, 6 strand rope using polypropylene MEDIUM twine. Finished length must be **5m** with one end to be completed with a backsplice and the other with 100mm loop. Twine will be provided. Rope length to be measured **ONLY AFTER SPLICING** (before rolling up). The rope making area will be cordoned off and situated next to the Heritage marquee. Only the competing teams, the judge, and stewards are allowed within the area. One item of rope making machinery may be set up before the starting time and fixed to the ground if necessary. Competitors will be allowed 30 minutes to complete their rope.

1. Individual entries – Classes (1 - 6) Entry 25p per class or £12 Show Membership (includes entry to Show) Open to members of a Young Farmers' Club and aged 14 – 28 years. Members may enter only one entry in each class. Exhibitors, who are not members of the Show, must pay admission to the Show Ground. Members will be admitted to the Show Ground free on production of a current Echt Show membership badge.

2. All Exhibits to be brought to the Show Ground between **8.00am and 9.00am**. No entries will be accepted once judging has commenced. The Industrial Tent will be open to the public from **12noon until 4.30pm**. Removal of exhibits between **4.45pm and 5.15pm**.

3. All Exhibits must be accompanied by a sealed envelope containing the name and address of Competitor and name of the Young Farmers Club they are a member of. The envelope should be **firmly attached to the article**. The number and name of the section only to be written on the outside of the envelope. Envelopes will be opened on awards being made or if goods are not collected by 5.15pm. **Exhibits not accompanied with the name and address will be disqualified.**

4. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and not previously shown at Echt Agricultural Show

5. All food exhibits must be exhibited in clean containers and covered. All food exhibits consumed after collection from the marquee, are consumed at the individual's own risk and the committee cannot be held responsible.

6. The Committee accept no responsibility whatever for any loss or damage to exhibits in the Show.

7. Protests in connection with the Show should be lodged with the Secretary by 3pm on Show Day and must be accompanied by a deposit of £10, which will be forfeited to the Society if the protest is found to be groundless.

8. Prize money will be paid approximately one month after the Show.
