1. Walking stick - plain wood head, one piece
2. Walking stick - plain wood head, two piece
3. Walking stick - fancy wood head
4. Walking stick - plain horn head
5. Walking stick - fancy horn head
6. Neck crook - lambing stick, plain wood
7. Neck crook - lambing stick, fancy wood head
8. Neck crook - lambing stick, plain horn head
9. Neck crook - lambing stick, fancy horn head
10. Leg cleek - plain wood, one or two piece
11. Leg cleek - plain horn head
12. Thumb stick - natural
13. Thumb stick - two piece, horn or wood

NOVICE SECTION

14. Crook or stick - plain or fancy wood head
15. Crook or stick - plain or fancy horn head

4. All exhibits must be the work of the Exhibitor and only 2 exhibits are permitted per class.
5. Novices can show for two years as a Novice.
6. All sticks must have been made since July 2021
7. The Committee accepts no responsibility whatsoever for any loss or damage to exhibits.
