## Vintage Tractors Rules and Regulations

- 1. Exhibitors are required to be on site by 10.00a.m. On Show day when entry can be gained from approximately 7.00a.m.
- 2. Two complimentary passes to the Show site will be issued to each entrant. For each entry after the first, an additional pass will be issued.
- 3. All drivers must be over 16 years, and hold an appropriate licence for the vehicle being driven.
- 4. The consumption of alcohol by drivers is prohibited.
- 5. Passengers are not permitted on tractors.
- 6. All drivers must ensure that their vehicles are licensed, insured, taxed and tested as necessary to meet legal requirements
- 7. All exhibits must be covered by Public Liability Insurance, a copy of which must be attached in order for the entry to be accepted
- 8. No exhibit should be left running unattended.
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible for the security of their vehicles. The organisers will not be held responsible for loss or damage to exhibits however caused.
- 10. The organisers will not be responsible for any accident that may occur from machinery or equipment belonging to any exhibitor. It is a condition of entry that exhibitors shall hold the organisers blameless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings or claims arising from any accident caused by their vehicles, machinery or equipment.
- 11. Vehicles may leave the Show from approximately 5p.m. (weather can often dictate timings)
- 12. Please cooperate with Echt Show stewards who are there to help.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY STATEMENT
